PLAY: It is the responsibility of each group to keep pace with the group ahead. The player's assistant has the authority to keep play moving at the proper pace for all players' enjoyment. If a group fails to keep its place in front, it must allow the group following to pass.

THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES SUPPLEMENT THE CURRENT USGA RULES OF GOLF

- Transition areas: The areas of sand marked by green stakes should be played as "Through the green." This means the player may take practice swings and ground the club at address.
- Cart Paths: Artificially surfaced cart paths are obstructions. All players are allowed to lift, clean and drop their ball within one club length of the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole. All sand paths are deemed to be integral parts of the golf course and no relief is afforded.
- All environmentally sensitive areas are defined as lateral water hazards and identified by red stakes with green tops. Entry into or play from these areas is prohibited. Players under penalty of one stroke proceed under rule 26.
- Immovable Obstruction Close to Putting Green: If a ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows; The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole; (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be cleaned when lifted. (App. 1 pp. 101)

CLUB POLICY

- All four tires must remain on the path around tees and greens.
- Please return to the cart path at or before the Black Posts located on the side of the fairway short of the green.
