USGA RULES Govern All Play except where modified by local rules.




LOCAL RULES OF PLAY

- Out of Bounds is defined by white lines / stakes, opposite side of water hazards bordering the golf course and inside edge of all roads / fences bordering the hole being played. Any ball beyond the lake bank on the non-fairway side of the lake is out of bounds.
- All water hazards are considered lateral and defined by red stakes and / or lines.
- Optional drop areas are provided on Holes #2, #3, #10 & #14. Player may use the next forward tee box.
- On Hole #18 a drop area is provided for the ladies behind the green. No drop area for Men.
- An embedded ball anywhere on the golf course, except in a hazard, may be lifted, cleaned and dropped within 1 club length, no closer to the hole, without a penalty.

GOLF CART RULES

- No carts inside markers approaching the green.
- Cart path only on all PAR 3's
- **Handicap carts must stay 15 feet from Greens, and exit on the cart path side. Do not drive behind greens to exit.**

PROPER ETIQUETTE

- Fill Divots with sand / Rake Bunkers / Repair Ball Marks.
- Rangers / Starters are for the benefit of all golfers, and they have the authority to insure your proper position and safety on the golf course.
- Flag System:  **Green:** play ready golf;  **Yellow:** increase speed of play;  **Red:** play is too slow, pick up ball and follow ranger.
